Applications

- To be considered for admission to Northern Kentucky University, you must [apply](#) and submit the necessary credentials. The deadline to apply for admission and be eligible for [scholarships](#) is February 15, 2021.

Credentials

- Request your school's counselor to submit your official high school transcript and a copy of your senior schedule to NKU's admissions department. They can submit this by email to nkuadmissions@nku.edu.
- Home-schooled and independent study students should submit a notarized transcript detailing the content of the curriculum and the duration of each subject to complete their admission file. Upon graduation, please submit a notarized official transcript that includes a graduation date.
- ACT/SAT scores must be received directly from the test agency or as a part of your official high school transcript. Freshmen applicants with a 2.7499 unweighted high school GPA and less will be required to submit ACT/SAT scores to complete their admissions file.

- Setup your myNKU account
 - First, go to password.nku.edu and enter your **NKU username** (can be found on your acceptance letter)
 - This will allow you to create a password that you'll use to log into your NKU email and myNKU accounts. Once you've created your password you can now access myNKU at mynku.nku.edu.

The myNKU portal is used for everything at NKU. View your financial aid, add/drop courses after you've met with your advisor, pay your tuition, **and much more.**

- Pay your confirmation fee
 - Your first step in confirming your enrollment is to pay the confirmation fee. There are 2 ways to pay your confirmation fee:
