Applications

- To be considered for admission to Northern Kentucky University, you must <u>apply</u> and submit the <u>necessary credentials</u>. The deadline to apply for admission and be eligible for <u>scholarships</u> is February 15, 2021.

Credentials

- Request your school's counselor to submit your official high school transcript and a copy of your senior schedule to NKU's admissions department. They can submit this by email to <u>nkuadmissions@nku.edu</u>.
- Home-schooled and independent study students should submit a notarized transcript detailing the content of the curriculum and the duration of each subject to complete their admission file. Upon graduation, please submit a notarized official transcript that includes a graduation date.
- ACT/SAT scores must be received directly from the test agency or as a part of your official high school transcript. Freshmen applicants with a 2.7499 unweighted high school GPA and less will be required to submit ACT/SAT scores to complete their admissions file.

- Setup your myNKU account
 - First, go to password.nku.edu and enter your **NKU username** (can be found on your acceptance letter)
 - This will allow you to create a password that you'll use to log into your NKU email and myNKU accounts. Once you've created your password you can now access myNKU at <u>mynku.nku.edu</u>.

The myNKU portal is used for everything at NKU. View your financial aid, add/drop courses after you've met with your advisor, pay your tuition, and much more.

- Pay your confirmation fee
 - Your first step in confirming your enrollment is to pay the confirmation fee. There are 2 ways to pay your confirmation fee:
 - Mail: send in your confirmation form along with the \$75 confirmation fee to the Office of Admissions
 - **Online:** pay by credit card or e-check through your myNKU account. You'll need to set up your <u>myNKU account</u> if you haven't already.
