- Bring a copy of your current class schedule to your advising meeting.
- Check the Registration Guide at nku.edu/registrar under "Registration" to see when and how to register for courses.

*Please note that you will not meet with an advisor or register for classes at Northern Exposure. Advising and course registration for new transfer students will take place during your advising appointment.

- Pay your \$100 orientation fee online at nku.edu/mynku or pay in person by visiting Lucas Administrative Center 301. Guests may also attend for \$50 per person.
- Veterans attending Northern Exposure can choose a veteranspecific track offered in the afternoon of each program. Contact us for more information at (859) 572-1967.
- Students who are transferring 24 credit hours or less MUST ATTEND Northern Exposure. See nku.edu/orientation for dates. \$100 fee applies.
- Students who are transferring 25+ credit hours MAY CHOOSE to attend either Northern Exposure or the Student Centered Online Orientation Program (SCOOP). \$100 fee applies. Visit nku.edu/scoop for more details or nku.edu/orientation for dates.
