ADMISSION CRITERIA

Requirements for admission to the Master in Arts in Education: Teacher as Leader as defined by the appropriate catalog include but not limited to:

- 1. Bachelor's degree from an accredited institution with a minimum GPA of 2.75, or a GPA of 3.0 on the last thirty (30) hours of credit completed
- 2. Official Transcripts from all Institutions
- 3. Graduate Record Examination (waived if cumulative undergraduate GPA was 3.0 or higher)
- 4. Supplemental application demonstrating applicant's use of critical thinking, communication, creativity, and collaboration
- 5. Copy of teaching certificate or out of state equivalent
- 6. Signed Teacher as Leader Admission Agreement
- 7. Signed Codes of Ethics for Kentucky School Personnel and College of Education

CURRICULUM CRITERIA

Individual Competence Development*: Zero to six (0-6) hours Any MA.Ed. Candidate who has never taken courses in the teaching of reading and introduction to special education will be required to do so as a part of this program. Professional Core: Fifteen (15) semester hours required) At least 15 hours must be taken in courses 600 or above. Concentration Core: Twelve (12) semester hours (with <u>prior</u> approval) and in accordance with program requirements or to strengthen the content/concentration of the student. Additional hours may be required to complete selected endorsement. Please see curriculum contract for selected endorsement requirements for certification requirements.

Elective Core: Three (3) semester hours.
