



## Honors College Curriculum—For Fall 2024 Admits

Most students starting at NKU in the Fall 2024 semester or later will follow this curriculum.\* Completing this curriculum with a 3.00 NKU Overall GPA and a 3.25 Honors GPA will earn the graduation distinction of “University Honors Scholar,” which appears on students’ transcripts and diplomas.
