
## Collaborating with an External Institution/IRB? Find out if you need a reliance agreement.



## NKU as the Reviewing IRB

 $\underline{\text{Meaning}}$  – the NKU IRB will serve as the reviewing IRB for the project

## Conditions –

- the relying IRB must agree and sign a formal reliance agreement.
- This typically happens after the NKU IRB has approved the project.

<u>Form</u> – NKU Reliance Agreement Template <u>Initiation</u> – the NKU IRB initiates and formalizes the agreement

## NKU as the Relying IRB

Meaning – the NKU IRB will rely on an external IRB to be the IRB of record (or reviewing IRB)

Conditions –

- the NKU IRB must receive relevant documents<sup>2</sup>
- the external IRB must have a federal wide assurance
- Both institutions must approve and sign the reliance agreement

<u>Form</u> – External IRB Reliance Agreement Template <u>Initiation</u> – the external IRB initiates and formalizes the agreement
