ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

Between
Northern Kentucky University
and
Ivy Tech Community College

For Transfer of Ivy Tech Community College's Associate of General Studies
to
Northern Kentucky University's Bachelor of Arts in Middle Grades Education

Statement of Purpose

The purpose of this articulation is to provide a basis for a cooperative relationship between Northern Kentucky University and Ivy Tech Community College (ITCC) to benefit students who desire to complete a bachelor's degree. The intent is for ITCC students completing the Associate of General Studies—under the specific AGS education track identified in Addendum One—to move seamlessly to the Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) in Middle Grades Education degree program.

Transfer Agreement

Ivy Tech Community College graduates from the Associate of General Studies program identified in Addendum One, from the Madison or Lawrenceburg campus, may transfer and apply the credits from that completed degree to requirements for Northern Kentucky University Bachelor of Arts in Middle Grades Education.

Addendum One: Ivy Tech Community College Associate of General Studies to B.A. in Middle Grades Education Checklist


Additionally, under the terms of this agreement:

1. ITCC students are eligible for admission with junior standing to Northern Kentucky University provided they submit a completed application and have a minimum of 60 credits with a 2.0 or higher grade point average on a 4-point scale. In addition, ITCC students must meet the selective admission requirements for a Bachelor of Arts in Middle Grades Education listed in the addendum to be accepted to NKU's Middle Grades Education program. These admission requirements include an overall minimum grade point average of 2.75, minimum grades in specified courses, and stated scores on the Praxis Core Academic Skills for Educators assessment.
2. ITCC students completing the Associate of General Studies degree before transferring to NKU will be certified in general education. Students who transfer to NKU before completing their Associate of General Studies degree will be required to complete NKU's general education curriculum and ITCC courses will be evaluated on a course-by-course basis.
3. The parties to this agreement are committed to an annual review of its details to adjust them for any relevant curricular changes at either institution. In the event of such changes, Northern Kentucky University will permit an ITCC student covered under this agreement to designate a catalog year (for purposes of applicable requirements) up to two years before the matriculation date at Northern Kentucky University.

4. Written notice of intention to terminate, modify, or withdraw from this Articulation Agreement will be submitted by the academic head of either institution at least one academic semester prior to the proposed date of termination/withdrawal. Should a decision be made to modify or dissolve this agreement, students who are already attending Northern Kentucky University at the time will be permitted to continue as long as their academic performance remains in good standing.
5. Under this agreement, ITCC students will be encouraged to complete their Associate of General Studies degree before transferring to Northern Kentucky University. Should an ITCC student transfer to Northern Kentucky University prior to completion of an Associate of General Studies degree, ITCC shall provide the opportunity for students to subsequently complete the Associate of General Studies degree in absentia using Northern Kentucky University course credit. In this interest, all coursework completed at Northern Kentucky University will be accepted and applied to the Associate of General Studies degree requirements at ITCC consistent with the criteria used for native ITCC students. The same course may also apply toward baccalaureate degree requirements at Northern Kentucky University. The student will, however, need to complete NKU's general education requirements if the student transfers to NKU prior to completing the Associate of General Studies degree.
6. The transfer agreement will take effect upon the affixing of signatures of the Parties named below.
7. This agreement becomes effective when all signatures are affixed and remains in effect for two years from the date below. After two years, the agreement may be renewed with or without modification by mutual agreement of both Ivy Tech Community College and Northern Kentucky University.



Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for the Associate of General Studies degree at Ivy Tech Community College and leads to the Bachelor of Arts in Middle Grades Education at Northern Kentucky University.

**Admission Requirements for a Bachelor of Arts in Middle Grades Education
 (Courses in parentheses are ITCC course equivalents)**


- A minimum overall GPA of 2.75
- A minimum grade of "B" in CMST 101 (COMM 101) and ENG 291 (ENGL 112)
- A minimum grade of "C" in all other pre-admission courses and required EDU and EDS courses which include EDU 300 (PSYC 201), EDU 305 (EDUC 101), EDU 313 (EDUC 201), EDU 316 (EDUC 255), and EDS 360 (EDUC 230).
- Praxis Core Academic Skills for Educators: Reading (5712) – 156 or higher, Writing (5722) – 162 or higher and Mathematics (5732) – 150 or higher
- Pass criminal background check
- 60 semester hours completed
- An acceptable portfolio
- A completed application to the Teacher Education program

Students pursuing a Middle Grades Education degree must complete the methods course and content courses in at least two of the following teaching fields: English and Communication, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, or Special Education. Special Education must be completed as a second major.
