My logo is a complete, simple graph of 4 points/vertices. Every point represents either myself or one of my best friends. The top left is a trefoil knot, which represents me. I like the look of it, and since there are three crossings I decided it fit me because I am one of three kids in my family. Since it is tri-colorable, I used my three favorite colors to color it. The top right icon, the Yin/Yang symbol, represents my friend Rachel. She is represented as this symbol because that illustrates our relationship well- we balance with each other (one example: she likes cold, cloudy, dark times whereas I like hot, sunny, light). The bottom right point is a heart, which represents my friend Cecilia. She is represented by this because 1) she is super sweet, and 2) we are basically each other's other half, and are always together.
