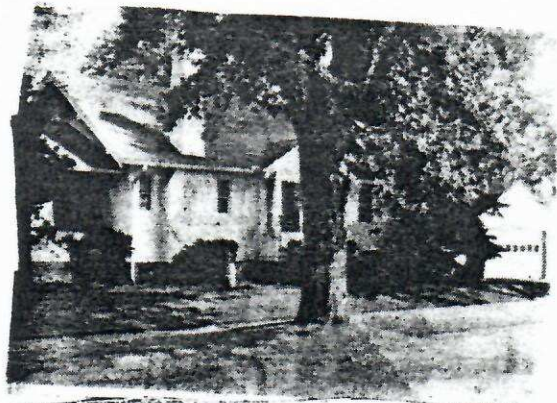

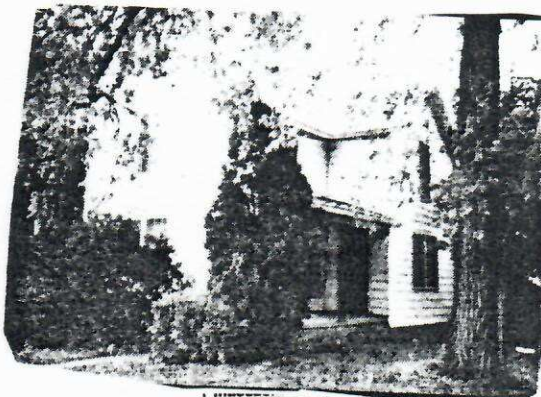

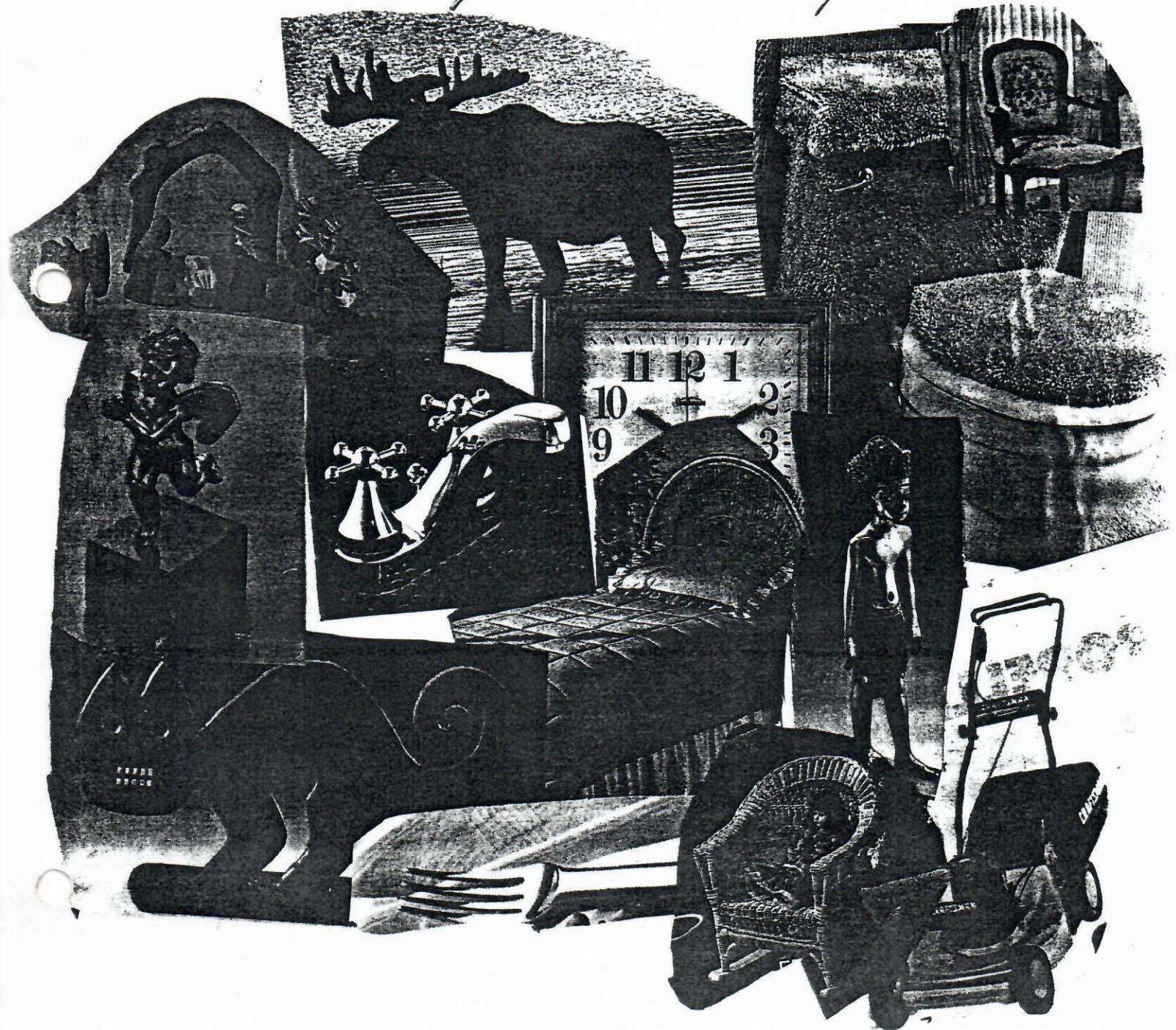

⑤ HAVING A BABY?



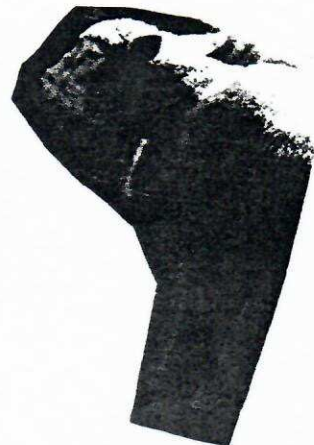
It's up to you, of course. But before you decide, there are some things you should know about babies:
